

URGENT NOTICE

FOR RECIPIENTS AND GUARANTORS OF STUDENT LOANS.



The **Ministry of Finance** wishes to **remind all student loan recipients** that student loans become due one year after graduation.

If you have outstanding balances on your account, you are immediately required to honour your obligation to begin repayment of the loan on the due date stated on your contract.

Payments can be made by:

1. Direct Payment to the Student Loan Agency through the use of cash or cheque; cheques must be addressed to the **Student Loan Agency, Ministry of Finance**.
2. Establishment of standing authorization or order from **Citizens bank, Scotiabank, Republic Bank** or **GBTI**.
3. Salary deduction authorization from your place of employment.
4. Payment via **GTT Mobile Money (MMG)**.

Failure to honour your repayment obligation constitutes a breach of contract, and **all appropriate actions will be taken**, including the **initiation of legal proceedings against defaulters**, by the **Ministry of Finance**, on behalf of the **Government of Guyana**, to recover the outstanding amounts. Guarantors of student loans are accordingly advised.
